Gwavas Homestead Garden & Puahanui Bush Tour

Morning tea on arrival sets the scene for this stunning day, after which guests will don their sturdy walking shoes for a walk through Gwavas' private 132-hectare Puahanui Bush. This virgin bush is of national significance with totara known to be more than 600 years old.

Guests will then be treated to a sit-down lunch before a tour of the majestic historic homestead and spectacular 9-hectare 'Cornish Woodland Garden'. An experience for all the senses, the Gwavas Garden is filled with beautiful birdlife and fragrances of the flowers in bloom.

Gather the family for a stunning Central Hawke's Bay picnic at Tikokino Peonies.

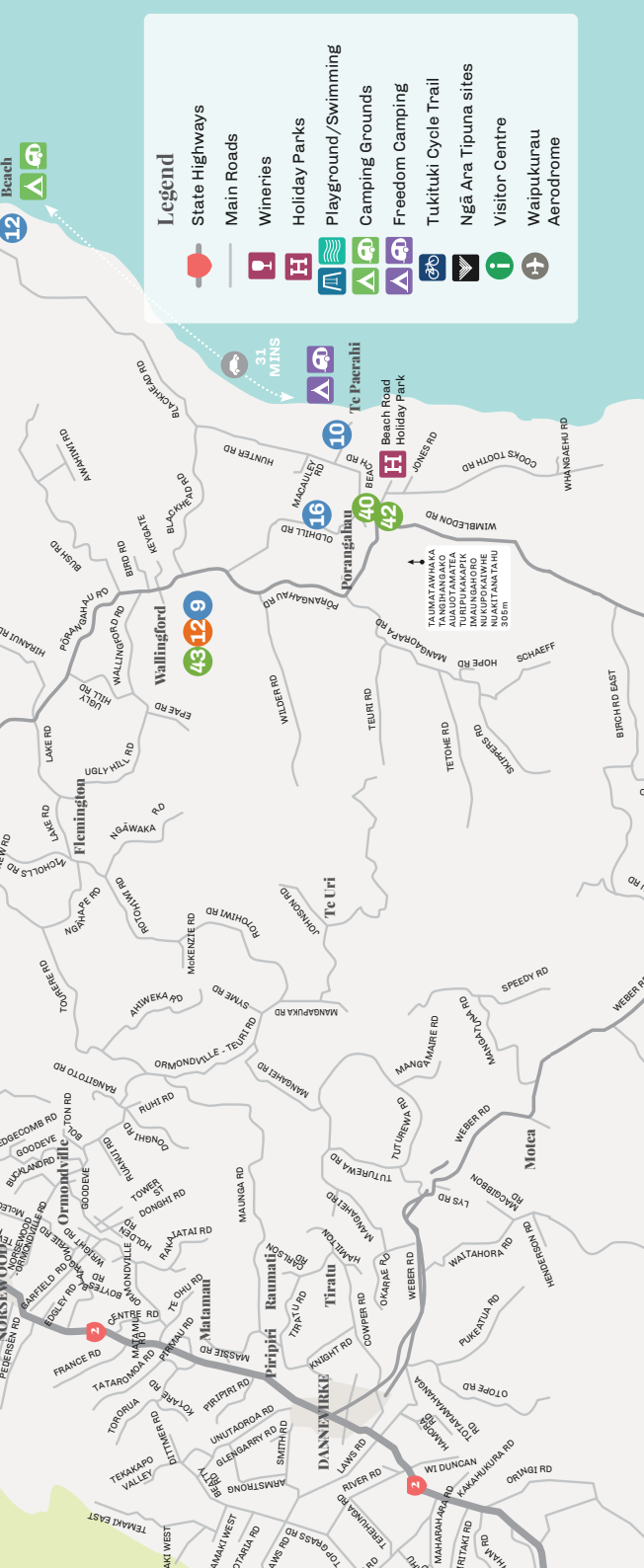
Precious peonies flower for just one month of the year, so this is a very special event with limited availability.

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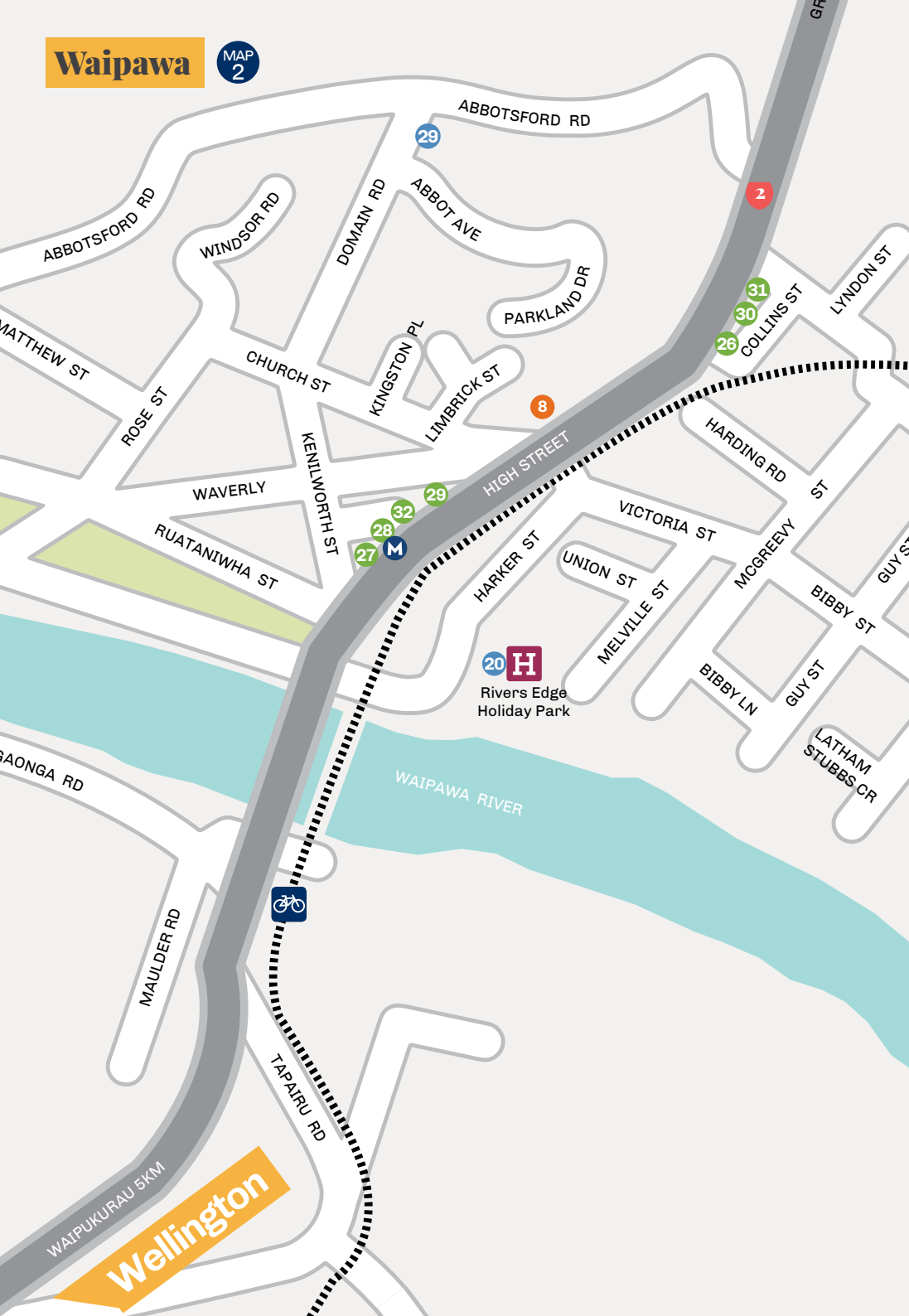
